- Allocating, rather than auctioning, emissions allowances to the electricity sector to help reduce increases in electricity prices for customers in their homes, businesses and factories and in all parts of the country—rural, urban or suburban.
- Including a “collar” on the price of emissions allowances with both a floor and ceiling. Setting a floor spurs innovation in new cleaner, energy technologies and a ceiling ensures prices don't rise so high that jobs and the economy are harmed.
