

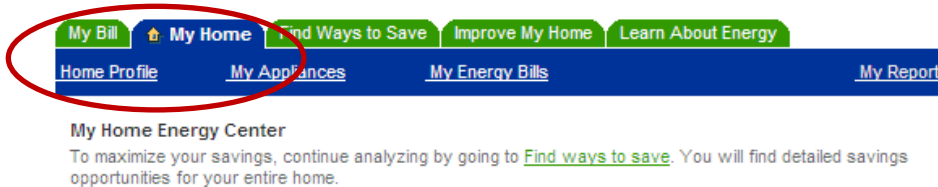


Five steps to complete a FREE online energy audit

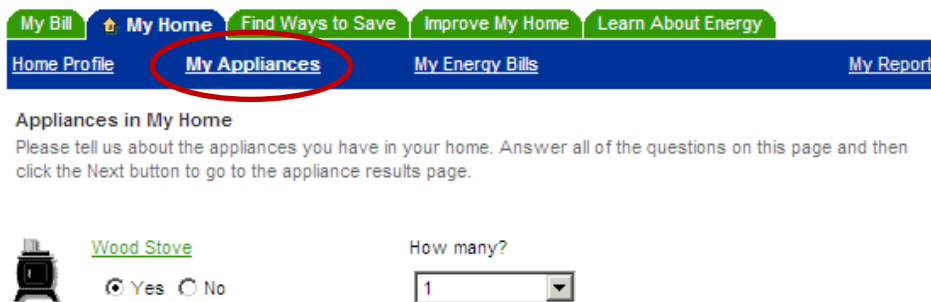
1. Click the **Open MyEnergy Analyzer** button to get started.
 - If you are not already signed in, you'll be prompted to sign in to your account.
 - If you don't have a user name and password, you'll need to follow the prompts to register. Have your DTE Energy Account Number handy to complete your registration.



2. Once you've reached the MyEnergy Analyzer Web site, choose the **My Home** tab, and then choose the **Home Profile** link. Answer the questions. Choose the **Next** button at the bottom of the screen to advance to the next step.



3. From the **My Home** tab, choose the **My Appliances** link. Answer the questions about your home appliances. Choose the **Next** button at the bottom of the screen to advance to the next step.



4. Next, from the **My Home** tab, choose the **My Energy Bills** link. If you are a Detroit Edison and/or MichCon customer, your billing history data will already be filled in. Fill in the blanks for any missing energy use data. Choose the **Next** button at the bottom of the screen to advance to the next step.
