Notice Prior to 12/1 Deadline: Customer provided notice of intent to return to Detroit Edison Full Service during the following summer prior to the December 1st deadline

RTS Form: The Notice of Customer Intent to Return to Full Service form is mailed to Electric Choice customers every October

Option 1 or 2: The Customer Election of Return Option form is mailed to customers who drop from Electric Choice service before December 1st

Option 1 - Customer commits to stay on Full Service for at least 12 months; Option 2 - Customer elects to stay on Full Service for less than 12 months

Past EC Minimum Term: Customer has met the Electric Choice minimum term of service of 2 years

Standard MPP Charge = Difference between the market price of power and the power supply portion of Detroit Edison's regulated rates

Summer Premium MPP Charge = Difference between the market price of power plus 10% and the power supply portion of Detroit Edison's regulated rates
