Making it Easier to Save

To participate in the program simply follow these steps:

- Check your eligibility with program requirements
- Submit a pre-approval application to reserve your funding
- Install the eligible measures according to the application specifications
- Complete, sign and submit final application with all documentation within 60 days of project completion

Many Ways to Save

Prescriptive measures include lighting fixtures, lamps and controls; heating, ventilating and air conditioning equipment and controls; gas water heaters; motors and variable speed drives; and other common energy efficiency measures. The incentive level varies, but can cover up to 50 percent of the energy efficiency investment. Detailed specifications for each measure are listed on the incentive application.

Examples of prescriptive measures:

- T12 to T8 standard fluorescent lighting with ballast
- Programmable thermostat
- Gas furnaces and boilers
- Boiler tune-up and steam trap repair / replacement
- Unitary and split A/C systems
- NEMA premium-efficiency motors
- Beverage machine controller
- Compact Fluorescent Lightbulbs (CFLs)
- Occupancy sensors
- Anti-sweat heater controls
- Compressed air nozzles
- Intelligent surge protectors
- Demand control ventilation
- Food service - electric and gas

Do you have an energy-saving project that's not on the prescriptive list? Consider applying for a custom incentive. Custom incentives are paid based on the project's first-year energy savings. New construction and renovation projects may also be eligible for incentives. Customers must submit a prenotification application for all custom projects.
