

## WARM WEATHER ADVISORY LIFTED This notice applies to all customers

Effective Gas Day March 6, Timely Cycle the Warm Weather Advisory is lifted. DTE will not be restricting interruptible storage injections and interruptible balancing injections.

## **SYSTEM WIDE:**

If nominated volumes exceed available system capacity at any location during this time period, capacity allocations will follow the category priorities outlined in the DTE Gas Company FERC Operating Statement Section 11.4; Capacity Allocation which follows Section E2.2 of the DTE Gas Rate Book.

## **IT RESTRICTION:**

Due to projected warm weather forecasts, expected operational conditions, and nomination levels, beginning Gas Day March 2<sup>nd</sup>, Timely Cycle, DTE Gas is restricting interruptible storage injections and interruptible balancing injections to **zero**. It is estimated that this restriction will be in place until further notice. DTE Gas will notify customers as soon as the restriction can be lifted.
