03/09/2026

Beginning Gas Day 10 – Timely Cycle DTE Gas' Force Majeure is lifted.

Please note the previous notice sent on 03/06/2026 is still in effect. Effective Gas Day 9 - Timely Cycle through Gas Day 13 – Intraday 3 Cycle, DTE Gas Operations may be constrained due to projected warm weather forecasts and increased nomination levels, which may impact Storage Injections and EUT Deliveries.

Pursuant to Section 21.1 of DTE'S FERC Operating Statement, DTE has declared a Force Majeure event due to an unexpected and uncontrollable compressor failure. **Beginning Gas Day 7 Intraday 1 Cycle**, all locations on the DTE Gas System except #9196 MICHCON - STORAGE WITHDRAWAL/POOL, #9002 BELLE RIVER MILLS-REC, and #9136 VECTOR BELLE RIVER-REC may be impacted.

DTE Gas requests that customers proactively watch for updated Operational Notices on DTE's eNominator System, Gas Noms Webpage, and direct emails.

DTE will provide an update on operating conditions by close of business on Wednesday, March 11, 2026.
