



### NOTICE OF PLANNED SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

**05/12/2022:**

DTE Gas will be performing an in-line inspection of a pipeline and other planned maintenance in June 2022. The inspection and subsequent remediation windows will constrain volumes moving through the pipeline segments and certain points as described below.

Schedule of Work:

Segments Impacted	Dates Impacted
Willow, Belle River	Jun 14 thru Jun 22
Willow, Belle River	Sep 26 thru Oct 7
Willow, Belle River	Oct 10 thru Dec 2

Gas entering DTE’s system at Willow Run (i.e., ANR Willow Run #9038, PEPL MCON #9028, Nexus Ypsilanti #9219) may be subject to capacity restrictions on the Willow Segment

Gas entering DTE’s system ***at any receipt point*** may be subject to capacity restrictions on the Belle River Segment. Gas destined for injection into DTE Gas Storage (i.e., MAP #9036 – Storage Injection, MAP #9501 – IBS Injection) may also be impacted.

**Interruptible storage and balancing service capacity may be restricted during the time frames listed above.**

**It is recommended that GCC Suppliers and Easement nominate their primary receipt locations to avoid nomination cuts.**

**PLEASE NOTE: This is not a request for EUTs to reduce usage.**

Actual segment capacity will vary depending upon pipeline operations, weather, and market conditions.

Maintenance is currently estimated to occur within the time frames listed above with an expectation that normal operations will resume between these time frames. **If nominated volumes exceed system capability during these times, there is the potential for nomination cuts to be made per Section 3.2 of the DTE Gas Rate Book.**

DTE requests that customers and gas suppliers proactively watch for updates to operational notices on DTE’s eNominator system, Gas Noms Webpage and direct emails during this critical period.
