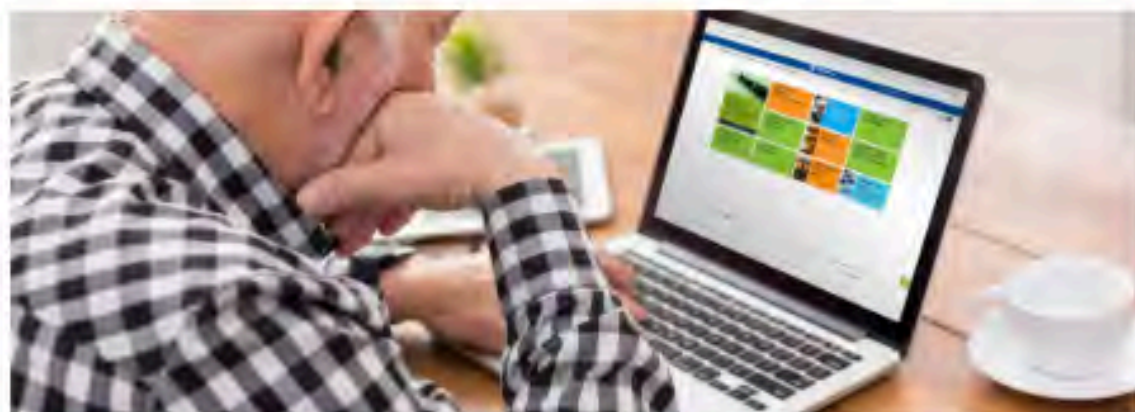
Beacon Park B-day Bash
